

Public Bank Group, Hong Kong: Promoting Sustainability through Green Month Campaign

Public Bank Group, Hong Kong (the "Group") launched the Green Month for the whole month of July 2023 by organising a series of activities with different weekly themes of sustainability trends.

The Green Month kickstarted the first week with the theme of sustainable travelling. As travelling restrictions were lifted, Corporate Culture & Social Responsibility ("CSR") Department shared green tips on how to travel responsibly, such as choosing transportation with the lowest carbon footprint.

For the second week, the theme of waste reduction was adopted. Through the "Clothes Donation" activity, Group staff donated over 50 clothing items to be forwarded to the Green Ladies and Green Little of St. James' Settlement, a social eco-enterprise that promotes environmental and social progress through fashion reuse and empowering middle-aged women re-entering the workforce. This activity not only reduced textile waste, but also supported a worthy cause.

大眾銀行集團(香港)("集團")於2023年整個7月舉辦綠色環保月("環保月"),並一連四週舉行一系列以可持續發展趨勢為主題的活動。

環保月開首以可持續旅遊為主題。隨著各地解除旅遊禁令,全球客運增加,企業文化及社會責任部("CSR部門")向員工分享責任旅遊小貼士及如何選擇最低碳足跡的旅遊交通工具。

集團於第二週舉行舊衣回收捐贈活動以提倡減廢。員工於活動期間共捐贈超過50件衣物予聖雅各福群會旗下環保社企 Green Ladies & Green Little。這兩所機構一直以推動環保為目標,透過收集優質時裝,積極推動及鼓勵二手時裝買賣,使社會資源有效循環再用。活動除了減少衣物廢料,更支持 Green Ladies 推動中年婦女就業的使命,別具意義。

For the third week, the theme of sustainable eating was encouraged. CSR Department shared tips to staff on which food have the lowest environmental impact, and staff were encouraged to embrace plant-based diets in benefitting their health and the planet.

For the fourth week, the theme of recycling was practiced through Coffee Grounds Soap Making Workshop held at the Bank's Training Centre and led by Eco-Greenergy, an environmental social enterprise dedicated to recycling coffee grounds and promoting sustainable practices. Nearly 20 staff participated in the workshop in designing and making their own unique soaps. In the workshop, staff learnt about the steps and benefits of repurposing coffee grounds, as well as the importance of sustainability.

On the last day of the fourth week, staff were encouraged to wear green on earth tone colours to work. Nearly 100 staff were dressed in earth tones and took group photos to demonstrate their ways of sustainability lifestyle. At the end of the Green Month Campaign, CSR Department gave each staff scented tea bags as thank you gift in appreciation of their participation. The Green Month Campaign and its activities with different themes of sustainability have indeed successfully engaged staff in showing their commitment to sustainability and inspiring them to make changes in their lives to go green.

於環保月的第三週,集團鼓勵員工實踐可持續飲食。CSR部門向員工介紹對環境影響最少的食物及分享植物性飲食的食譜,讓員工認識持續飲食對健康和環境保護的益處。

第四週,集團於大眾銀行中心舉辦咖啡渣手工規工作坊,並希望透過活動帶出廢物回收的重要。工作坊由環保社企緣行俠(Eco-Greenergy)領導,近20名員工參加。參加者從中了解重用咖啡渣的好處,及親手設計和製作手工規。

環保月的最後一天,集團鼓勵員工穿上大地色系的衣服上班,以示支持綠色生活。近100名員工響應活動,他們除了身穿指定服飾,更與同事伙伴拍照展示綠色生活。CSR部門為答謝員工的支持及參與,向他們送上清香花茶作小禮物。集團透過綠色環保月,進一步推動員工承諾支持可持續發展及鼓勵他們改變生活模式,一起邁向綠色生活。

Public Bank Group, Hong Kong (the "Group") organised a Mid-Autumn Festival caring programme with a series of activities in sharing festive joy with low-income elderly and spreading the message of care and respect to the elderly among staff. There were a total 25 staff volunteers participating in the programme which contributed approximately 40 volunteer hours of community work.

The Group collaborated with a local non-governmental organization ("NGO"), Shun Lee Neighbourhood Elderly Centre, Hong Kong Christian Service in holding this festive programme. On 11 September 2023, volunteers gathered in the training room at the Public Bank Centre working as a team in packing 100 care packages. Each package was thoroughly checked by the volunteers in ensuring all food items were in place with no missing items.

On 23 September 2023, the volunteers joined the "Visit the Elderly and Deliver Care Packages" activity. Upon arrival, they were briefed by the NGO representative on the difficulties the elderly and caretakers faced and were taught useful skills in communicating with the elderly. The volunteers were then divided into small groups bringing along the care packages for their home visits.

with compassion, care, and understanding and presented care packages and mooncakes donated by staff to them. The volunteers visited over 30 elderly, comprising singleton, doubleton and hidden elderly.

At the end of the visit, the volunteers gathered for a debriefing where they reflected on how they could take care of their own parents better. They also learnt that aging should not be an obstacle for a person to live an energetic and meaningful life if they strive for it, as demonstrated by the elderly.

Last but not least, the Corporate Culture & Social Responsibility Department expressed their appreciation to the Group staffs' enthusiastic support for the mooncake donation where a total of 170 pieces of mooncake were collected. Besides giving to the elderly, some mooncakes were also donated to Saint Barnabas' Society and Home, an NGO that supports people experiencing homelessness to integrate them back into society and provides meals to people living in poverty. This year the mooncake donation to both the elderly and the homeless

This programme offers summer internship placements to undergraduate students from the Faculty of Social Sciences. This summer, two students, Jamie Chung (Year 2) and Russell Mak (Year 3), were offered positions in the Bank Corporate Culture and Social Responsibility ("CSR") Department from 6 June to 28 July 2023. Public Bank (Hong Kong) Limited: Launching of Energy Conservation Initiative

大眾銀行(香港)有限公司:推行節約 能源措施

To combat climate change, the Public Bank (Hong Kong) Limited (the "Bank") trialled a new rewards scheme for all departments and branches on electricity usage. Using data compiled during the first 6 months of the year (January to June) over the past 2 years (2022 to 2023), the Bank was able to identify department and branches that reached their target energy saving rate as compared to the previous year of similar timing.

大眾銀行(香港)有限公司("本行")為應對氣候變化,減少二氧化碳排放,遂推行慳電獎勵先導計劃。本行收集各部門及分行於2022年及2023年首6個月的用電數據及進行比較,以得出成功達到節電目標的部門及分行。

The successful branches that managed to achieve the target 3% reduction rate were located at Hunghom, Tseung Kwan O, Kwun Tong and Wan Chai. For their tremendous effort in helping to save the planet, the Bank rewarded nearly 30 employees at branches with gift vouchers in recognising their green acts on energy conservation in reducing wasteful energy consumption.

成功達到3%節電目標的單位為紅磡、將軍澳、觀塘及灣仔分行。為獎勵他們成功節省能源,及肯定他們為應對氣候變化作出貢獻,本行向近30名分行員工頒發禮券。

The Branch Managers of these four locations shared their energy-saving strategies, such as cutting off electricity usage after 5pm at certain areas at the branch with less employees working and setting air conditioner temperatures to be around 25°C and turning off all electricity when leaving the branch.

四間得獎分行的經理分享了節省能源方法,例如於下午5點後局部關燈,並只保留員工工作區域的燈光;室內溫度亦全日維持在攝氏25度;員工在離開分行時確保所有電源關閉。

These energy-saving strategies have indeed incentivised departments and branches to be more environmentally-conscious in saving electricity and at the same time protecting the planet.

是次節約能源計劃有助提高各員工的環保意識,推動節約用電,同時愛護我們的地球。
